

## Key

1. Create 'hedgehog highways' in your fences to connect your gardens.
2. Provide an escape route out of ponds - hedgehogs are great swimmers but they struggle to climb out.
3. Create a variety of habitats eg: ponds, hedges, log piles and compost heaps to attract food for the hedgehog.
4. Build a hedgehog home - give them somewhere to hunker down for winter.
5. Let some grass grow wild to encourage hedgehog prey. Check carefully before strimming or mowing any areas.
6. Create nesting opportunities - leave quiet areas for hedgehogs to nest and hibernate.
7. Set up a feeding station offering hedgehog food or meaty pet food and clean water.
8. Tidy up! Litter harms wildlife and hedgehogs can become tangled in netting and twine.
9. Keep domestic drains and holes covered, hedgehogs can fall into them and get stuck.
10. Check bonfires before lighting and ideally rebuild elsewhere.
